

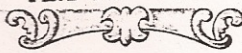

be paid as soon after my death as shall be convenient.

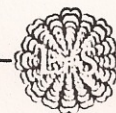
SECOND: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real,

Imhoff Bullen, Barbara Imhoff Lavalley, Walter Imhoff, Jr., and June
Imhoff, share and share alike.

Lastly I hereby appoint my husband, Walter Imhoff executor
Should he die with me, I appoint Peter Imhoff, my brother-in-law
executor
of this, my last Will and Testament: hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
