COURT UPHOLDS AWARDS TO 5 MISHAP VICTIMS

By a 2 to 1 decision judgments totaling \$5,950 against the Village of Whitesboro and the New York State Railway in the Village of Whitesboro, N. Y., were rendered by the Appellate Division in Rochester.

Two \$1,000 verdicts were rendered in favor of Justice Henry J. Kimball in Superior Court here more than a year ago. The largest verdicts were \$1,000 each for William H. Vanderland, 31, 12 Linwood, Whitesboro, now serving in the U. S. Army at Camp Shelby, Miss., and Mrs. Elizabeth Gutbain, 34, 12 Linwood, Whitesboro.

The accident occurred when a car operated by Robert Caryl, Whitesboro, in which Vanderland was a passenger, struck a street car on the park in Whitesboro. The collision with a car driven by Robert Caryl, Whitesboro, was a passenger. Vanderland was the owner of the latter car.

Attorneys for the plaintiffs, alleged that the village and the street railway company were negligent in the maintenance of the street and of the car tracks. They claimed the accident followed after wheels of the Caryl car struck a section of track which was three inches above the pavement.
