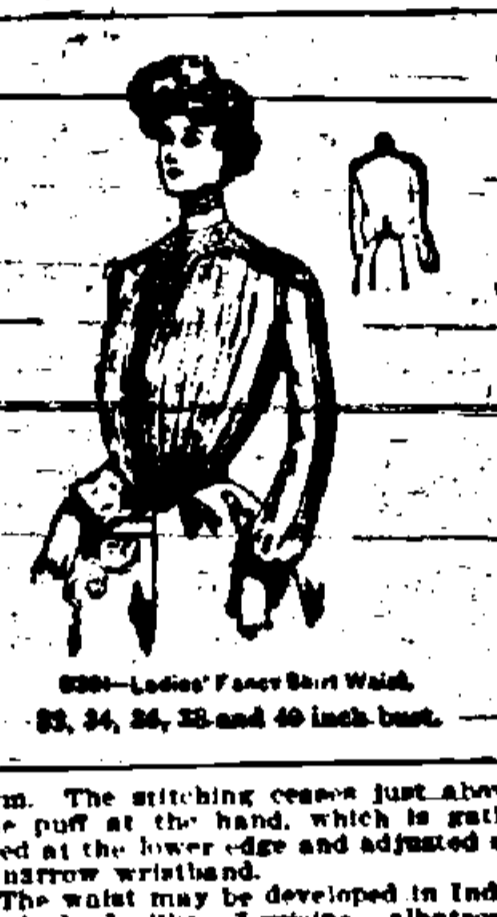

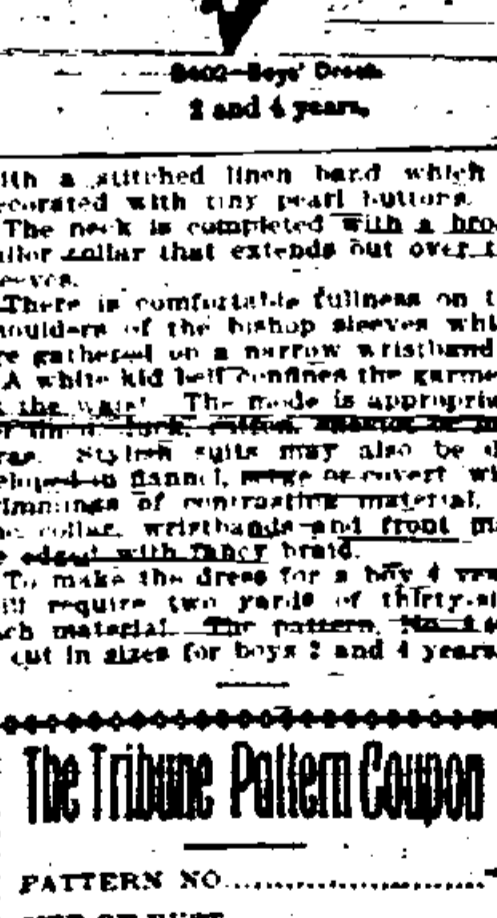
TRIBUNE PATTERNS.

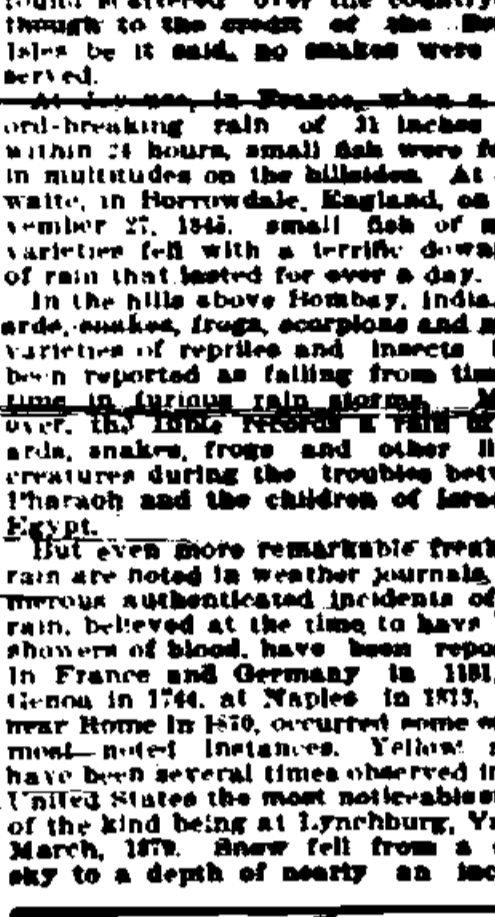


Ladies' Fancy Long Sleeve. 32, 34, 36, 38 and 40 inch waist.

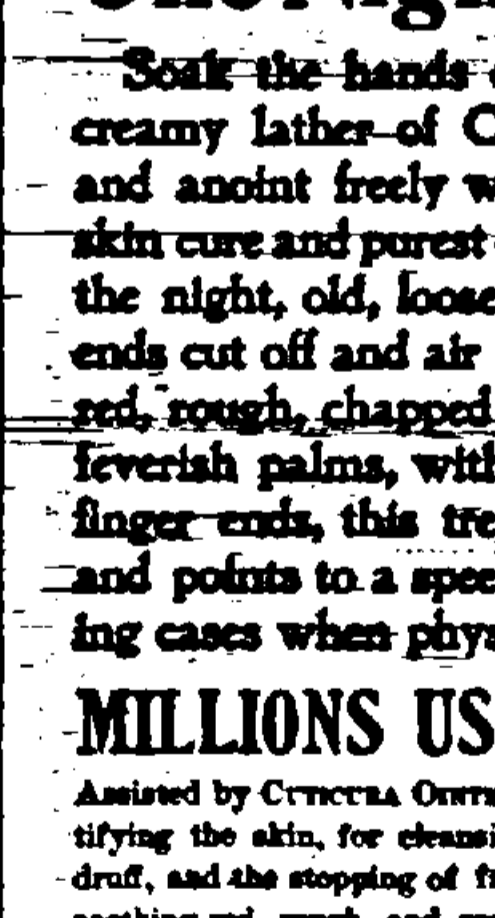
QUEER THINGS.

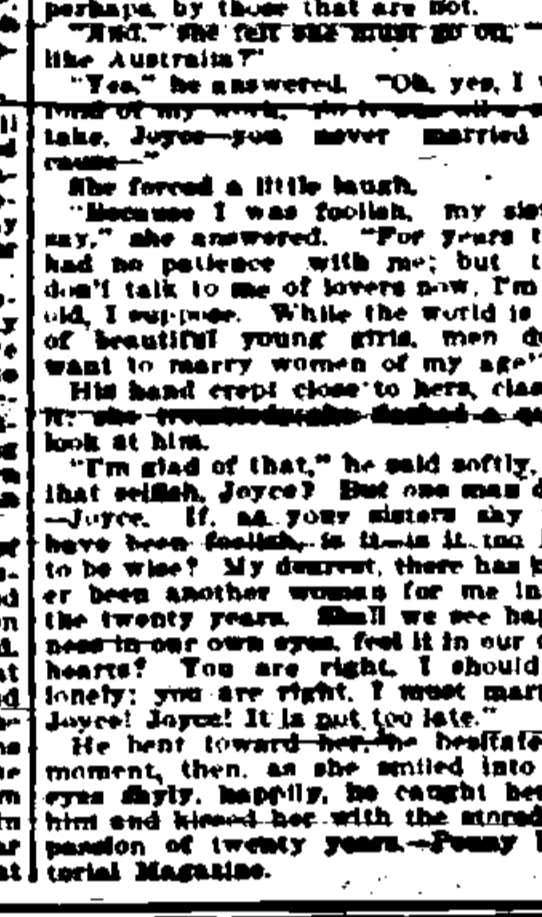


Tick found in office of the bishop.
