Captain Ryan Now a Major

Capt. John W. Ryan, post adjutant of Madison Barracks since October, 1940, and a son of Mr. and Mrs. John P. Ryan, 221 Rutger, has been promoted to major in the Infantry with the rank effective Feb. 1, 1942, it was announced today by Col. David E. Cain, commander of that post.

With the promotion, Major Ryan assumed the duties of post executive officer formerly held by Lieut. Col. John H. Ahrens, who was transferred recently to the Second Corps Area Headquarters, Governors Island.

Native of Utica

Major Ryan, a native of Utica, attended Wetmore School and the Utica Free Academy. In 1927 he was graduated by Syracuse University with the degree of bachelor of business administration. Also, he attended the American Institute of Banking classes while attending college. Major Ryan worked evenings as clerk in the Hotel Syracuse.

He started his military career as a cadet in the Syracuse University Officers Training Corps. After being commissioned a second lieutenant in the Infantry Reserve, he attended the summer camp for officers and was an instructor in the Civilian Military Training Corps. From 1933 to 1937 he served in Company I, 10th Infantry, New York National Guard. He was promoted to first Lieutenant in 1935 and to captain in 1940.

Major Ryan married the former Loretta C. Luebert of Utica and they have four children, Michael, Jane, James and Sally, who live at Madison Barracks.

Was Bank Employee

From 1929 until the time he was called for active duty Major Ryan was employed as bookkeeper and teller at the Savings Bank of Utica.

The major is a member of Beta Sigma fraternity, the honorary business management fraternity at Syracuse University. Capt. William S. Bailey Jr., commanding officer of the station complement, will succeed Major Ryan as adjutant.
