from Cologne, has a pop. of 506.

2. Frommersbach a village of 266, is near Trier Rhineland,

RR station Zerf this is due south of Trier on a side RR line

Above are the only names in this book, and narrows it
down to 2 places. - and the Family records of Imhoff start in
Davos Switzerland, where Wilhelm 1289 and his son Jaegli 1332
were Land-Amt-Mannwith former names in records as in Curia,
de Curia also de Villa. later Hans im Hof living on a farm
Lauingen 1341, married to Anna v.Gundelfingen. He settled in
Nueremberg and was member of the council. 1351. there is much
genealog. and hist. literature . Crest:red shield with head
and forelegs of Lion ending with fish-tail upwards, like a
mermaid.
